



WORK SHEET – EXERCISE 7C

Situations for role plays

Here are some situations you can use as topics for role plays or sketches. Child **A** plays the role of the angry person and **B** helps them. **C** plays the role of the observer, like a director or a camera. They are not allowed to speak during the role play. Afterwards you take turns, so everyone plays all three characters.

A student is angry that he didn't get the part he wanted in a theatre play.

A child took another child's ball on the playground.

A child stumbles and falls down the stairs; the other child that pushed him doesn't help him get up again.

A child rips another child's painting apart and throws it in the bin!

A student calls his classmate a "baby".
